<p>RMT (Registered Music Teacher)</p>	<p>Uses R.M.T. designation. Votes at Provincial Association meetings. Includes Conservatory Associateships, and those with degrees such as Bachelor of Musical Arts, Bachelor of Music, Master of Music, Doctor of Music, and those accepted as members by the Provincial Association. These could include experienced teachers who are deemed equivalent by the provincial Membership Committee. They have met ALL criteria set out by the P.E.I.R.M.T.A.</p>
<p>Affiliate Member</p>	<p>This category includes experienced teachers who are deemed equivalent by the provincial by-laws. They have not met ALL criteria set out for full provincial RMT membership. Affiliate Members will be categorized in one of the three Affiliate Member Levels (as outlined below). The category placement depends on the requirements outstanding for full membership. Allowed to vote but not to hold office nationally. May hold office locally and/or provincially. Will receive Canadian Music Teacher Not entitled to use RMT designation</p>
<p>AM1 Affiliate Member Level 1</p>	<p>Completed Grade 10 Conservatory with all theory OR École de musique Vincent d'Indy Neuvième Année – Laureat II</p>
<p>AM2 Affiliate Member Level 2</p>	<p>Completed Grade 9 Conservatory with all theory OR École de musique Vincent d'Indy Septième Année - Supérieur II</p>
<p>AM3 Affiliate Member Level 3</p>	<p>Other as determined by the Membership Committee.</p>
<p>Auxiliary Member</p>	<p>Supports goals of the Association but does not teach. Does not use the RMT designation after his/her name. Does not vote at meetings. This category could include individuals such as retired music teachers, music publishers, owners or managers of music stores, music librarians, instrument technicians, representatives of music festivals, music students and other supporters of music. Entitled to most benefits of membership.</p>
<p>LM Life Member</p>	<p>May be granted upon the recommendation of the Executive Council to those who have rendered meritorious service. All provincial dues, and insurance if required, for Life Members shall be paid by the P.E.I.R.M.T.A.</p>

LIABILITY INSURANCE:

Liability Insurance is provided for each member at a special rate of \$25.00 per year. This provides \$5,000,000.00 coverage for claims (due to injuries) which may arise from music teaching and related activities occurring in the teacher's home-based studio or on the premises. Members are also covered for activities performed outside of the home as they act in the capacity as members of the PEIRMTA. Liability insurance is strongly recommended for teachers with home-based studios but is not compulsory for members of the PEIRMTA.

APPLICATION DETAILS:

Individuals may apply for membership to the PEIRMTA at any time. However, applications must be received by April 15 of any year in order to be included in the published Directory for the following year, though their listing will appear on the website at an earlier date. The application must include the following:

- 1) Cheque payable to PEIRMTA. The amount is determined by the type of membership requested and if insurance is required. The registration fee is payable once only.
- 2) Current resume.
- 3) Photocopies of degrees and diplomas.
- 4) Two letters of reference which are to be written by any of the following: a member of the PEIRMTA, a member of the PEIMEA, an RMT from any province or a former instructor from a recognized institution.
